Health and safety in our industry begins with the product, we only source our materials from reputable suppliers who are compliant with NASC code of practice.

Materials

We hold a vast stock of genuine Layher system scaffolding which is purchased directly from Layher and our approved suppliers George Roberts, this product is tested prior to production at Layher facilities to ensure only the highest quality material is approved for manufacturing. Following production, components are regularly assessed and tested for safe

performance by deconstruction testing giving our workforce the confidence and reassurance in the product for use. This technically advanced system allows for significant productivity gains over tube and fitting scaffolds and other systems scaffold. This system has enhanced safety through the use of purpose-designed components, made to fit around irregular shapes and profiles. It requires no ledger bracing, which provides the greatest possible access to work faces, while allowing speedy modifications to structures with no loose components.

Quality systems and procedures

We are committed to ensuring that the service we deliver exceeds our clients requirements and expectations. Our quality management system and procedures ensures that all our employees work to meet the requirements of ISO 9001. We have measurable objectives to monitor this.

areas of our business, we have a proven track record with bringing our apprentices successfully through the apprenticeship and receiving full time long term employment and becoming valued members of our team which we believe is a vital part of our long term objectives.

All of our managers have a minimum of CSCS SMSTS qualification, we have taken this a step further, all our managers are now either qualified or working towards Nebosh General Health and Safety certification to ensure they have the knowledge to lead our teams safely through a variety of demanding projects. All supervisors hold a

minimum of CSCS SSSTS qualification and we ensure that our workforce has a supervisor ratio no greater than 1:5 therefore ensuring sufficient supervision on all contracts to ensure they are delivered safely and to programme.

Our employees carry out a wide spectrum of accredited training courses ranging from courses such as asbestos management, asbestos awareness, First Aid, Scaffold inspection, Rescue training, IPAF, Confined space, Banksman, TG4:11, SG6, working at height, SG4, TG20 to First aid and Behavioural training.


INDUSTRIAL




Further to our successful completion on various previous schemes in Healthcare we believe that with our knowledge and experience we are the perfect partner in this sector.

Our recent projects include a new build Mental health hospital at Atherleigh park in Leigh which was a new state of the art £40 million facility. Layher system scaffold was utilised on this project providing a scaffold suitable and safe for multiple trades. We have also recently carried out a full

encapsulation scheme at Aintree Hospital to allow roof covering to be exposed whilst not impacting on the live hospital below. This was carried out using a temporary roof system combined with flame retardant shrinkwrap sheeting to the external façade of the scaffolding was also carried out safely working through a live environment by extensive planning, assessing and mitigating any potential risks prior to commencement on site.

RETAIL



We carry out numerous projects on retail premises, these premises are more often than not live premises where there is an interface with the public, such as banks, supermarkets and shopping centres for example. At Summit we understand this and the potential risks that this can bring.

We pride ourselves in our innovative approach and offer our clients bespoke solutions to these projects, such as pedestrian tunnels using Layher Protect panels to ensure a professional scaffold

solution suited to the project to allow members of the public safe access. We can also provide encapsulation with branding upon it to lower the impact to passing trade of the works being carried out.

Public safety is at the forefront of the planning stage of these projects and we endeavour when possible to carry the works out of normal working hours if permitted, all works are thoroughly planned and risk assessed ensuring

sufficient exclusion zones are in place to protect the public from the works. Our teams carry out regular point of works risk assessments throughout each shift as the working environment can change to ensure exclusion zones are sufficient and works can be carried out safely.

SHRINKWRAP



Summit offer the full encapsulation service, our operatives are trained and competent to erect shrinkwrap sheeting therefore a seamless transition from erecting the scaffold to providing encapsulation is possible. We have experience in many applications including providing zipped window and door openings to provide access and ventilation when required. About Shrinkwrap scaffold shrink wrap is a strong and durable plastic cladding that

matches every protection or containment need: from shielding the workforce and tools from poor weather to protecting the environment against the dust and debris generated on site.

Shrinkwrap sheeting is heat shrunk to create a 'drum tight' and tear resistant covering over roofs and facades of any size or shaped scaffold structure. The sheets of scaffold shrink wrap are heat welded




together to create a continuous, bonded skin without the holes or gaps typical of traditional sheeting.

The shrinkwrap used is manufactured to contain UV inhibitors and ethylene-vinyl acetate (EVA) to prevent it becoming brittle when used long-term. Plus it contains anti-static and flame retardant additives to make it safe and easy to use around the work environment.


